Youth: Ages 12-16

Extreme Bowhunter and Bow Hunter Classes Equipment Rules:

No magnification or stabilizers longer than 18". A front stabilizer or a system including quick releases, enhancers and/or weights may be used, but may not exceed twelve inches (18") in total length from the tip of the stabilizer (or system) to the point of attachment on the front of the riser provided by the manufacturer. A rear stabilizer or a back bar system (V-bar) may be used with no restriction on bar length. Bow Hunting set-ups only.

Examples of a Single Pin Dial Sight: HHA Tetra Max or Spot Hogg Fast Eddie with NO Magnification.

Arrows: The MAX ARROW SIZE FOR ALL BOWHUNTER CLASSES IS .309 Outside Diameter. An example of that would be a Gold Tip Hunter XT 250 spine arrow. Must use screw-in points. No broadheads allowed. No lighted nocks allowed.

Senior Class is 50-year-olds and older.
